A trophy will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place for church floats, business floats, and non-profit floats.

And you must have a copy of the report on you during the parade. Also, you are only allowed to bring the number of horses you have paid for and stated on this application. *****Judging of Entries*****

Judging for all entries will take place during the parade. However, the judges may walk around at the lineup just to become familiar with the entries. In addition to the judging of floats, musical groups, antique cars, horses & dogs, one trophy will be awarded for the "Grand Champion --- Most Creative Use of Lights" entry. Also, one trophy will be awarded for the "Grand Champion --- Best Themed" entry. **ALL ENTRIES** qualify to be eligible for the latter two trophies.

*****Lineup and Winners*****

The lineup will be posted online starting Thursday, December 5th at www.downtownsobo.com. Winners will be announced online Sunday, December 8th and in the newspaper Monday, December 9th. Trophies can be picked up at the Main Street Office at 432 Main Street in Town Hall beginning on Monday, December 9th.

*****Requirements*****

Each entry **MUST** display their organization name on the front of their parade entry. This assures all entries that the announcer and/or newspaper will identify your entry correctly. If you cancel your entry, please call us at 434-575-4208.

South Boston Christmas Parade Information

Order of Lineup, Parade Route, Lining Up / Check-In, Judging of Floats, Unloading, Port-a-Johns



1. The Order of Lineup:

The lineup will be posted online starting Thursday, December 5th at www.downtownsobo.com, or you may call the parade line at 434-575-4208 and ask for your lineup number.

2. Parade Route:

The parade route starts at the intersection of Wilborn Ave. and Chalmers St. in front of Enterprise Rent-A-Car. The parade continues down Wilborn Ave. to Main Street in Downtown South Boston, turning right at the corner of Main Street and Seymour Drive. There will be **NO STOPPING AND/OR PERFORMING** anywhere on the parade route, including the Sponsors Viewing Tent.

3. Lining Up / Check-In:

You can arrive as early as you like and find your own stake with your name and lineup number, but a parade representative will be staffed at the lineup area starting at 2:00 p.m. to direct you to your lineup position. **Please arrive no later than 4 p.m.** From Wilborn Ave. turn onto Chalmers St. at Enterprise Rent-A-Car. You must stop and “**Check In**” with the parade representative located there. Your lineup number will be posted at your location and there will be port-a-johns at the lineup area. If you have an extra long float entry, the earlier you get in the lineup, the easier it will be for you.

4. Judging of Floats:

The judging of floats will take place during the parade. However, the judges may be walking around at lineup time to familiarize themselves with the entries. **You must display your organization name and lineup number on the FRONT of your entry. This assures all entries that the announcer and/or newspaper will identify your entry correctly. If the judges cannot identify an entry, it will not be judged.** All winners will be announced on www.downtownsobo.com on Sunday, December 8th.

5. Unloading:

Please do not stop your entry anywhere on Seymour Drive between Main St. and Factory Street. South Boston Police request that no entry stop at the intersection of Seymour Drive (Constitution Square area) and Factory Street. Entries are to turn right on Factory Street and continue back toward the beginning of the parade at least until you have passed SunTrust. When you have passed SunTrust, you may stop and unload. Stopping on Seymour Drive causes traffic congestion and makes the parade back up.

6. Lineup Port-A-Johns:

For your convenience, port-a-johns will be located in the grassy area near Valero on Chalmers Street.



2019 Christmas Parade Rules



(Read, sign and return with application. A copy will be sent to you.)

*****Please review the rules and be sure they are understood by those who are on your entry.**

1. All Christmas Parade applications and entry fees must be in and paid by the deadline to participate in the parade. The deadline is 12 noon, Friday, December 6, 2019. Any entry that has not paid their entry fee by the start of the parade will not be allowed to participate.
2. Please, only one “Santa” is allowed – he has already accepted our invitation to attend. Any entry that has Santa on their entry will not be allowed into the parade. The ‘Parade Santa’ will be the last entry in the parade. We do however encourage you to dress as elves, cartoon characters, etc. to fit the holiday theme.
3. All entries must use Christmas themes, and decorations. All vehicles must be in keeping with the Christmas spirit.
4. No motorcycles, go carts, three/four wheelers, dirt bikes, buses or tractor trailers (unless the tractor trailer is pulling an entry) are allowed in the parade unless approved previously by DDSB. No one under the age of 18 years old will be allowed to drive any vehicle in the parade.
5. No vehicles are to spin tires, rev engines or cause a commotion of any kind while participating in the parade. If this is violated, it will result in your entry being removed from the parade. No entry fee will be refunded.
6. Candy cannot be thrown to the crowd. However, candy may be handed out to parade attendees by walking beside your entry.
7. All dogs in the Dog category must be dressed, on a leash and walk with the designated dog group.
8. Christmas Parade Committee members reserve the right to ask any horseback rider whose horse is not under control to exit the parade. No entry fee will be refunded.
9. No entries will be allowed to stop during the parade. You must keep the parade moving at all times. Stopping and socializing with parade spectators is not allowed. The Sponsors VIP tent is NOT the judges’ area.
10. Christmas Parade Committee Members reserve the right to disqualify and remove any entry before the parade, at parade lineup, or during the parade due to noncompliance of these rules. Anyone behaving inappropriately will be removed immediately from the parade. This includes entries, participants, drivers, or anyone connected with your entry. No entry fee will be refunded.
